

CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY

December 7, 2018

This notification is to advise you of construction activity next week, specifically Friday, December 14, that will impact your ability to use California Avenue during paving operations.

As the construction of University Terrace nears its completion, Stanford is required by the City of Palo Alto to repave California Avenue along the entire frontage of the project (please refer to map). Since this is a City Street, the scheduling of this has been done by the project's sitework contractor in consultation with the City's Public Works Department. It was determined on Thursday, 12/6, that this will be done next Friday, 12/14, in consideration of upcoming weather forecasts and year-end holiday schedules.

There will be some preparation work taking place on Thursday, December 13; however, this will not interrupt vehicle use on all streets where this preparation work is taking place.


The work will require grinding and repaving all of California Avenue in front of the University Terrace project. This will make the use of California Avenue in front of the project impossible for much of the day, which may well be a major inconvenience for you. The City of Palo Alto Public Works department has approved and requires the work to start at 7:00am to ensure completion in one day. This action mitigates the need to disrupt the community for multiple days.

Stanford Real Estate and the contractor have provided the following logistical information for University Terrace residence:

- If you envision that it will be necessary for you to use California Avenue with your vehicle during the day on Friday, it is suggested that you park it the night before in College Terrace across California Avenue on Amherst, Bowdoin, or Columbia Streets. If you live in University Terrace and do not wish to do this the night before, it will be possible to drive out of University Terrace at the Columbia Street exit until 8:30am, as the contractor will be flagging that crossing at that exit until that time.
 - IF YOU LIVE ALONG BOWDOIN OR AMHERST STREETS within University Terrace, *your streets will also be repaved on Friday* (in addition to the California Avenue work outside of the project), and it will be necessary for you to **PARK ON DRAKE WAY THE NIGHT BEFORE** if you need to use your personal vehicle on Friday and if you have not parked it in across California Avenue in the College Terrace neighborhood the night before (by parking on Drake Way, you would be able to get out via the Columbia Street exit before 8:30am).
- During the day on Friday it will be possible to come and go from University Terrace by bicycle, scooter, or walking via the sidewalk to Hanover Street.
- In an emergency, if you need to come and go during the day via California Avenue and are unable to do so by walking, scooter, or bicycle, the contractor's phone number is (415-233-1059) for you to use to reach them to assist you in getting across California Avenue to your vehicle if the status of construction permits.
- It will be possible to drive your vehicle on and across California Avenue at the end of the day. The contractor projects that this will not be earlier than 5:00pm, but also notes that it could be slightly later than this in the effort to get all this work done in just one day.

City of Palo Alto Public Works Department and Contractor have provided the following logistical information for College Terrace residents:

- If you envision using your vehicle and your driveway abuts the paving zone, please relocate your car to the noted parking areas to allow you to use your vehicle during paving operations.
- Your cooperation is appreciated for this limited time, noting if may be necessary for you and your neighbors in University Terrace to park on College Terrace streets to accommodate this paving operation.
